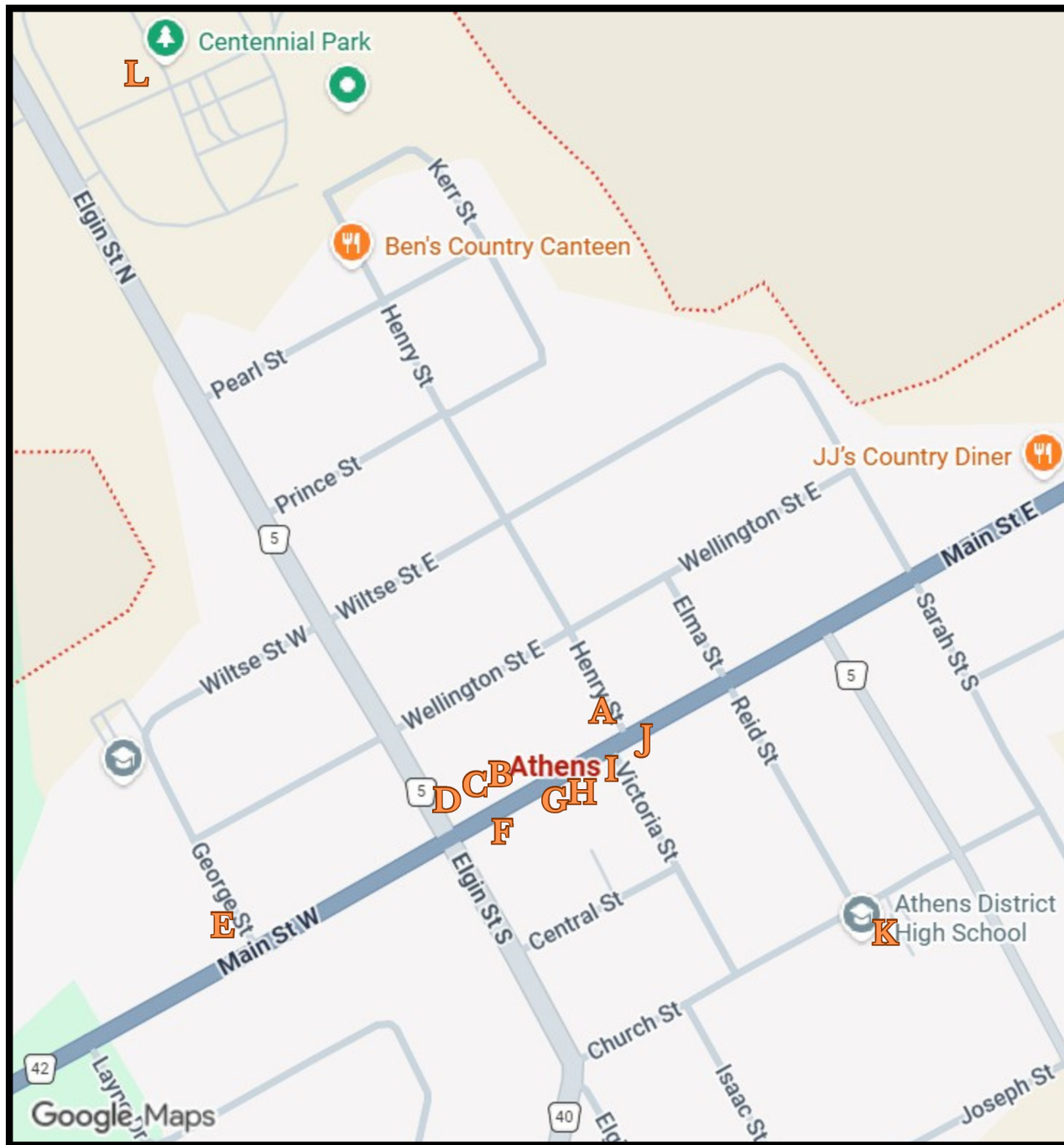

The Murals of Athens Ontario



A 34 MAIN ST EAST - B&W RAILWAY (2019)

Depicting memories of the Brockville and Westport (B&W) Railway that existed in Athens from 1888-1952, the mural was painted in 2019 by Keith Heine to replace the previous B&W Railway mural that was here.

B 22 MAIN ST EAST - THE GATHERING (1987)

Pierre Hardy was commissioned in 1987 to reproduce a 1927 original painting by Crawford Slack.

In 2020, Dave Sheridan refreshed the mural.

Pierre is on the ladder and Crawford Slack appears in the upper right corner.

C 2 MAIN ST EAST - EAST WALL HIGHWAY 42 EAST IN 1890'S (1994)

Mary Lynn Baker completed her third Athens Mural on the east wall of 2 Main St. E. This mural depicts historical activities and buildings in the Athens area. A numbering system helps the viewer identify which building is which.

D 2 MAIN ST EAST - WEST WALL JOSHUA BATES (2001)

This mural depicting the life of a founding father was painted in 2001 by a group of Athens Christian School students under the direction of Tony Endhoven. This mural was originally on the wall of Charleston Lake Storage Building.

E 16 MAIN ST W - ATHENS FIRE DEPARTMENT - THE MOST HEROIC DEED EVER DONE IN ATHENS (1990)

The mural depicts courageous men, women, and children as they attempt to stop the fire behind a former shop on Main Street. Also depicted is Mr J Rosenbarker who risked his life to contain the fire. This mural was originally painted by Mary Lynn Baker in 1990. Repainted in 2009. Repainted again in 2022 by Dave Sheridan.

F 7 MAIN ST E - MAIN ST. ATHENS CIRCA 1910 (1986)

Painted by Andrea Green, this mural depicts an early Main St. scene featuring notable Athens figures such as Edna B. Chant. The mural is on the east wall of 7 Main St. E, and was restored in 2019 by Dave and Diane Sheridan.

G 17 MAIN ST EAST - CHARLESTON LAKE PICNIC (1987)

Artist Noreen Mallory depicts a 1915 picnic on Charleston Lake. Athens residents Crawford Slack and Jennie Lamb can be seen. The mural was restored in 2019.

H 17 MAIN ST. E - INTERIOR WALL STEP INTO THE PAST (1997)

Artist Sheila Ballantyne depicts a social gathering on the porch of an old stone house.

I 23 MAIN ST EAST - THE HARVEST (2023)

Depicting farming of the past, this is the largest mural in Athens. It was designed and painted by Dave Sheridan. The Mural was funded by the late Helen and Ivan Pike.

J 29 MAIN ST EAST - SOLDIERS AND MAIN STREET DIGITAL IMAGES MURAL (2019)

One photo depicts soldiers on parade in Athens "Dedicated to the Canadian troops who trained in the Athens area and who served in the First World War (circa 1915)"

The other is a photo taken in front of 34 Main Street titled "Main Street of Athens Looking East circa 1920".

K 21 CHURCH ST - ATHENS HIGH SCHOOL CIRCA 1921 (1989)

Located on the north side of the Athens District High School, Artist Brian Sawatzky depicted the last graduating class of the school before the disastrous fire in 1921 which destroyed the original Athens High School building.

The mural was repainted in 2021 by Dave Sheridan.

L CENTENNIAL PARK - PAVILION CHRISTOPHER PERKINS ARCHER (2024)

Artist Dave Sheridan depicts Athens resident 2011 World Champion Archer Christopher Perkins with his bow and arrow.
